DEATH NOTICE

The Rev. F. Lee Richards. February 1, 1918 – February 2, 2011

The Rev. F. Lee Richards was born in Philadelphia on February 1, 1918. He received his B.A. degree from Lehigh University in 1948, his M.Div. degree Virginia Theological Seminary in 1951, and his S.T.M. degree from Temple University in 1954. He served as vicar of St. Andrew's in the Field, Somerton, 1951–1954, Trinity Church, Whitinsville, Massachusetts, 1955–1960, St. Stephen's, Cohasset, Massachusetts, 1960–1970, and St. Peter's, Third and Pine Streets, Philadelphia, 1970–1985. In the Diocese of Massachusetts, he was on the Executive Council and chaired both the Christian Social Relations and National and World Missions Departments. In the Diocese of Pennsylvania, from 1977–2005, he served as Diocesan Historiographer and Chair of the Diocesan History Commission, in which capacity he edited *Spanning Four Centuries: Pages of Parish History of the Episcopal Diocese of Pennsylvania* on the occasion of the diocese's hosting of the 1997 General Convention in Philadelphia. He is survived by Harriet, his wife of fifty-eight years, and their three children, Frederick, Ashton, and Martha.

The Burial Office will be on Saturday, February 12, 2011 at 2 pm at St. Mary's Church, Cathedral Road. The burial is to be out of town.
