The Rev. Henry J. Sharp was born in East Liverpool, OH, August 9, 1929, the son of Harry Jay Sharp and Helen Margaret. He graduated from Kenyon College, Gambier, OH with a BA, 1953. He then graduated from Philadelphia Divinity School, Philadelphia, PA, with an MDiv. In 1956, Fr. Sharp was ordained a Deacon May 12, 1956, by the Rt. Rev. Joseph Gresham Armstrong, and Priest on November 17, 1956 by the Rt. Rev. Oliver J. Hart. On June 5, 1954 he was joined in marriage to Charlotte Ellis Sharp; of this marriage four children were born. Fr. Sharp served as Rector of St. Paul's Memorial Church from 1960 to 1994 when he retired. He also served as Vicar of the Church of the Ascension, Parkesburg, PA 1957-1960, and Vicar of St. Bartholomew's Church, Philadelphia 1956-1957. He was a member of the Philadelphia Clericus from 1968-1993.
